<p>Job Summary : (English, max 1000 characters)</p> <p>The post-doc will contribute to the PolEco project: The Eurocracy revisited in the light of the trajectories of political auxiliaries. Sociology of the relations between politics and economy. PolEco project aims at studying the concrete relations between the political and the economic field, based on a sociological investigation of agents who have occupied a position in the European Parliament: accredited parliamentary assistants. By looking at their successive positions, at possible conflict of interest situations, and at the knowledge and expertise valorized both in the European Parliament and in the economic field, the study should highlight the logics of movement and their variability in the European political area. The post-doc must have a good knowledge of political sociology, an expertise on European political field, a broad experience in sociological investigation, and a good mastering of English and French languages.</p>

The project is part of the activities of the laboratory SAGE at the University of Strasbourg. The bulk of the mission will consist of two tasks. The first is to collect data on former accredited parliamentary assistants (their profiles, their career trajectories and their practices). The second is to do and to analyze interviews with former assistants who have become interest representatives. The interviews in French, English or another language will be conducted largely in Brussels.</p>
