Master Erasmus Mundus Euroculture – Faculté des langues :

- Perception des droits d'inscription

EXPOSE DES MOTIFS :

Le master mention langues et interculturalités spécialité relations internationales et langues, porté par la Faculté des langues, comporte un parcours « Euroculture » qui a obtenu le label d'excellence ERASMUS MUNDUS accordé par la Commission européenne.

L'université de Strasbourg fait partie du consortium des huit universités européennes engagées dans ce programme :

- Université de Groningen, Pays-Bas
- Université d'Uppsala, Suède
- Université de Göttingen, Allemagne
- Université Jagellone de Cracovie, Pologne
- Université Palacký d'Olomouc, République Tchèque
- Université d'Udine, Italie
- Université de Deusto à Bilbao, Espagne
- Université de Strasbourg, France

Quatre autres universités de pays tiers (hors Union Européenne) sont associées à ce master Erasmus Mundus :

- Université de Purdue à Indianapolis, Etats-Unis d'Amérique
- Université nationale autonome du Mexique à Mexico
- Université de Savitribai Phule à Pune, Inde
- Université d'Osaka, Japon

L'université de Groningen aux Pays-Bas assure la coordination de ce réseau et est chargée de recueillir les droits d'inscription des étudiants participant à ce programme. L'Université de Groningen reverse ensuite à chaque université membre du consortium les droits d'inscription des étudiants originaires de cette université, selon l'accord de consortium pour la période 2017-2022 approuvé au CA du 14/11/2017. Les sommes sont versées en deux parties, au premier semestre pour le 3^{ème} semestre de M2 et 1^{er} semestre de M1 et au deuxième semestre pour les 4^{ème} semestre de M2 et 2^{ème} semestre de M1. Les deux premières conventions jointes concernent la première phase de paiement, à savoir le premier semestre de la cohorte 2020-2022 et le troisième semestre de la cohorte 2019-2021.

Les deux suivantes concernent la deuxième phase de paiement, à savoir le deuxième semestre de la cohorte 2020-2022 et le quatrième semestre de la cohorte 2019-2021.

Il est à noter qu'il y a une déduction des frais de recherche répartis entre chaque membre du consortium.

Pour rappel, l'Université de Strasbourg perçoit :

- la répartition de la subvention du consortium au titre du label master Erasmus Mundus ;
- les droits annuels pour les étudiants ressortissants de l'Union européenne et ayant comme université d'origine l'université de Strasbourg : 1 250 € ;
- les droits annuels pour les étudiants non ressortissants de l'Union européenne et ayant comme université d'origine l'Université de Strasbourg : 3 500 €.



Hereby, it is agreed upon that the following payments will be made in the context of the Erasmus Mundus Euroculture programme for 2020-2022: 1st semester. The amounts are based on the agreed amounts as laid down in the Financial Agreement Euroculture 2020-2022. Payment of 3rd and 4th semester fees will be arranged for later, pending the choices of the respective students of where they will study in those semesters.

The University of Groningen, as Chair of the Euroculture Consortium, has collected the tuition fees for self-financing EU and non-EU students studying in the consortium, as well as for EM scholarship holding students. For EM scholarship-holding students it has been agreed that each university will receive an equal share of fee money obtained from the European Commission irrespective of where the student spends the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th semester. The amount that is to be distributed across the European partner universities will be calculated per year (year 1 and year 2) and will be based on the incoming fees of EM scholarship holding students divided by 8 and with deduction of the third-country mobility.

The University of Groningen will pay to the University of Strasbourg the total amount of € **34,802.31** covering the fees for 1st semester of group 2020-2022.

The total amount to be paid to the University of Strasbourg can be broken down as follows:

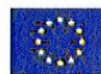

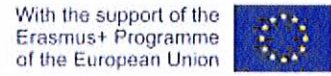
